GENERAL INFORMATION

Visiting Teams can access the coliseum through the loading dock area located on the North Parking Lot. Parking for visiting team bus is located in the North Parking lot along the curb of the sidewalk. DIRECTIONS

> From South & North bound I-77

Take exit 82-B (Cherry Road). Merge onto Cherry Road (SC 21—South). Follow Cherry Road for 3 miles to the intersection of Cherry and Richmond Drive. Turn left onto Richmond Drive. Keep straight up the hill to the intersection of Richmond and Eden Terrace. The Winthrop University Coliseum and other athletic facilities are directly across the intersection.

> From Charlotte—Douglas Airport

Follow Billy Graham Parkway to I-77. Follow southbound I-77 directions above.

> From Southbound I-85

In Charlotte, take I-77 south to Rock Hill. Follow southbound I-77 directions above.

> From North bound I-85

Proceed to Exit 102 (Earl, SC). Turn right onto SC 198, which will junction with SC Highway 5. Follow Highway 5 to Rock Hill. In Rock Hill, turn left onto Cherry Road (SC 322). Travel 1.5 miles to Richmond Drive. Turn right onto Richmond Drive. The Winthrop University Coliseum and other athletic facilities are directly across the intersection.

> From SC Route 72

Turn left onto SC Route 901 (Heckle Bypass). Proceed to SC 322 (Cherry Road); turn right and travel approximately 2 miles to Richmond Drive. Turn right onto Richmond Drive. Keep straight up the hill to the intersection of Richmond Drive and Eden Terrace. The Winthrop Coliseum and other athletic facilities are directly across the intersection.



Modalities available include cold and hot whirlpool, hot hydrocollator, electrical muscle stimulation, ultrasound, extremity pump and paraffin bath. We request written authorization from an ATC for treatments of ultrasound and electrical muscle stimulation on athletes unaccompanied by a certified athletic trainer.
